

Knowing and complying with the law is important.

For churches, knowing what the law is when it comes to reporting child abuse and neglect can be difficult and confusing. This training will help address such difficult questions as:

- What are the behavioral and physical indicators of abuse or neglect?
- Are all individuals who work directly with children mandated by law to report suspected child abuse or neglect? Who do they contact?
- Can individuals report abuse or neglect to the pastor, or do they need to make the call to Summit County Children Services?
- What could happen to an individual (within the church) who does not report suspected abuse or neglect?

These are real issues and concerns for many churches locally and across the state. Summit County Children Services has trained staff who can address these issues and offer child abuse and neglect awareness information so churches can have a better understanding of reporting laws and be better prepared to face these issues if they arise.
